Florida District 2 and Viera/Suntree Little League are honored to host the 2009 Senior League Baseball Southeast Regional Tournament in Viera, Florida. I take this opportunity to congratulate you on winning your State Tournament and look forward to seeing you in Viera.

Following is information concerning the tournament. Please contact us with your travel plans as soon as possible. You may also use the two web sites to find useful links for amenities in the area.

We will be providing all team with housing and with either food or food money while they are at the Region Tournament. If a team does not accept out housing, they are on their own as to expenses for housing, transportation and food. Friends and family members of the team are on their own as to all arrangements. There will be no reimbursement from the host district/league. You and your teams will be housed at the CROWNE PLAZA HOTEL 2605 N Highway A1A, Indialantic Florida, until the day after your elimination. Four (4) complimentary rooms have already been reserved for your team at this hotel. Please contact them ASAP to confirm your reservation. Their phone number is **321-775-0072**. When confirming the reservations, be sure to tell the hotel that this is for the **Senior Baseball Regional Tournament of Little League**. For any family members wanting to make reservations for the tournament, they should contact the Crowne Plaza directly at 321-775-0072, and state that they are coming for the Little League Regional Tournament. They must contact the hotel directly ( do not book online or by 800 number) to get a discounted rate. We have negotiated a special rate with the hotel. Be reminded that the **Region winner will fly out of Orlando International Airport on Saturday August 15<sup>th</sup>, 2008 at 6:10 a.m.** The Region winner can either remain in Viera, until the flight or can go home and then return for the flight (which has been reserved by Little League Baseball). After the World Series in Maine, the team has a flight back to Orlando (as per Little League Baseball).

The Host League will provide either (2) meals per day of their choice or the money stipend required by Little League Baseball. You will be notified the day before, of the meals for the next day. All other meals will be the responsibility of the team.

No transportation will be provided during your stay in Viera.

You and your team will be expected to attend all scheduled functions in conjunction with the Tournament.

Have a safe trip to Viera and good luck to your team on their last stop before the World Series in Bangor, Maine.

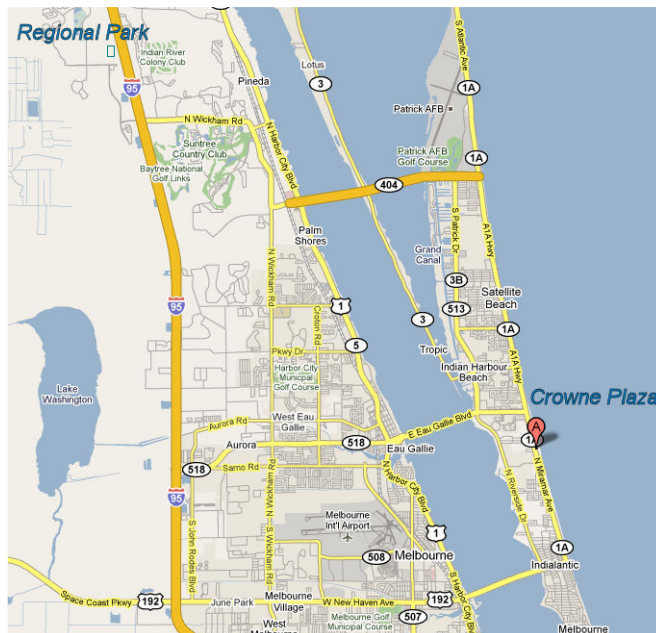
The playing fields have grass infields.

**Directions to Park**

TAKE 1-95 NORTH OR SOUTH TO EXIT 191 AND TURN WEST ON WICKHAM ROAD. PROCEED WEST ON WICKHAM ROAD TO TRAFFIC CIRCLE. MAKE RIGHT AT TRAFFIC CIRCLE ONTO LAKE ANDREW DRIVE. PROCEED TO JUDGE FRAN JAMIESON WAY (PAST THE MALL). MAKE A RIGHT ON JUDGE FRAN JAMIESON WAY AND THEN AN IMMEDIATE LEFT INTO VIERA REGIONAL PARK. FOLLOW ROAD TO BASEBALL FIELDS IN REAR OF PARK.



## General Information

- There will be a MANDATORY Team Manager Meeting on Friday, August 7 at 8:30 a.m.. The Coaching staff, League Presidents and District Administrators are invited. At this meeting the tournament format, schedule and rules will be discussed. If you have any questions about this tournament, get them asked and answered at this meeting.
- The following will be collected at the above meeting and reviewed before the first game:

### Team Affidavits and supporting paperwork Medical Release Forms

- Games will be played in accordance with Little League Tournament Rules
- Umpires will check all equipment prior to each game. Faulty equipment will be removed from the field and held by the Tournament Director until properly repaired or you have completed play in this tournament
- Pitching Affidavits will be filled out completely following each game in your Field Pressbox. The manager is responsible to assure that the Affidavits are accurate. Affidavits will be in the possession of the Tournament Director for the duration of your tournament play
- Teams should arrive 1 hour prior to the start of your scheduled game time
- Warm up fields and batting cages are provided. No hitting balls against the fences
- Teams must pick up trash in the dugout before vacating dugouts
- No coolers are allowed inside the park( with the exception of a team cooler, brought in by the coaching staff and remaining in the dugout). Please support the host league concession stand
- Smoking is not allowed by the playing fields
- Obscene language or harassment by anyone will not be tolerated. Offenders will be ejected from the park. Please instruct your cheering section of this request. All have now been warned.

## **BEFORE YOU ARRIVE**

- Check your Eligibility Affidavit to make sure it is complete and accurate from the State Tournament and that you have all the supporting documentation required by the Affidavit(map, Reg. II-d or IV-h forms, Combined League Play Form, Proof of Residency forms, etc)
- List your Players with a Pronunciation Sheet for the announcers
- Check all your equipment for cracks, dents, and other safety issues and replace all equipment that is unsafe or out of tolerances so it will not be removed by the umpires during the tournament.
- Since we will be playing "POOL PLAY" for this tournament, we will be reviewing the Pool Play bracket and the "Tie Breaker" rules for Pool Play. It is imperative that all Managers and the Tournament Officials understand the Tiebreaker rules the same way before the tournament starts
